As a CRB umbrella body, Synarbor is 100% committed to safeguarding children and vulnerable adults and as a result we have set in place strict guidelines enforcing our commitment. We train our home tutors on health and safety using guidance issued by the Health and Safety Commissionq Education Service Advisory Committee and ensure that all home tutors:

- are briefed about the area in which they will be working;
- are provided with all relevant information on particular pupils and their families,
- are fully trained in strategies for the prevention of violence;
- in particular, information about pupils with aggressive tendencies, or aggressive pets, or who come from families with a history of violence which can help prevent violent incidents occurring;
- are aware of the need to leave an itinerary with expected departure/arrival times with a responsible contact, who knows how to react if the person has not returned when expected and to phone colleagues about possible changes of plan;
- have arranged a prior appointment with the parent whom they are going to meet and do not enter the house if either the child is at home alone or if the parent, with whom the appointment has been made, is not there. In some cases it will be important to stipulate, when arranging an appointment that, if one of the childsq parents has caused problems in the past, that parent should not be present during the visit;
- are aware of the importance of leaving the home immediately if they feel uncomfortable in any way;
- carry forms for reporting incidents;
- avoid evening visits wherever possible;
- carry a mobile phone or an alarm;
- carry an identity card, and show it on a first home visit;
- do not carry large quantities of cash when making home visits.
